Summary of Evidence

Tegel has an overarching Environmental Policy endorsed by the Chief Operating Officer and a documented Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) management system which all sites are required to comply with.

Roles and responsibilities of relevant site managers is clearly defined and the site is supported by Regional EHS staff who are based at the Carmen Road site.

The site management team are committed to controlling odour and preventing impact on the community. This is evidenced by the installment of plant improvements such as the Biofilter redesign, protein recovery plant ventilation and waste water tank lid.

In addition, we have developed a documented Odour Management Plan which outlines the controls in place to reduce the risk of objectionable odours beyond the site perimeter.

Ongoing regular monitoring of site conditions and annual reviews of the Odour Management Plan will ensure that the site are effective in the management of odour.

Tegel has considered the evidence of Mr Paul Whyte for the Ministry of Education, particularly with regard to the Odour Management Plan. Further refinements have been made in response to that evidence, as shown in yellow highlight in the updated Plan now provided.
