## **Reasons comment:**

Continued employment in the Selwyn/Canterbury Region - Canterbury Coal Mine (CCM) currently employ's ~40 full-time workers from the Canterbury region which injects millions of dollars into the local economy each year. Proximity to destination - Canterbury Coal's location with respect to it's customers means that truck miles are very low, without CCM, coal would need to be trucked in from the West Coast which increases pollution for increased trucking but also has an increased risk of accidents from increased distanced travelled and interaction by trucking companies. Essential Service - In light of the recent Covid-19 pandemic, CCM was still operating as an essential service, supplying coal to the dairy industry as well as for heating in hospitals. Environmental Performance - CCM has worked hard to improve the environmental performance of its mine, by ensuring no water leaves site without being captured and processed first. Community Involvement - CCM has undertaken a number of community projects including, but not limited to, building a BMX track at Glentunnel, landscaping the Glentunnel school playground, assisting with the Glentunnel museum, and donating money to sports teams in the district. Flow on effects of the mine - As well as employing ~40 personnel, CCM supports 50+ local businesses through trades and contracting.
