Reasons comment:

For environmental reasons, coal mining and coal burning should be phased out, not

expanded as the consents desire. Ecan has declared a state of climate emergency, and therefore must consider whether or not the consents requested help to ameliorate such a state. Renewable energy is now cheaper than fossil fuel derived energy: biofuel or electric heating options exist and should be vigorously pursued. Coal burning equates to more than 5% of NZ greenhouse gas emissions; substituting currently available renewable energy for coal use would be a substantial and readily achievable step in the path to net zero carbon for NZ.
