Reasons comment:

A) I oppose the use of coal in a time of climate emergency. A new clean and sustainable

way of processing dairy products, heating schools and so on must be found. Ecam should not be putting the health of the community and the environment at risk with dirty out-dated projects such as this. B) Bathurst Mines have proved they are not to be trusted, they have breached their consents repeatedly and polluted waterways. This is not a company to be trusted with anything precious such as the endangered Mudfish. c) The coal from this mine is part of a polluting unsustainable dairy industry. New Zealand milk should be used to produce high value products, not milk powder. D) Coal dust, noise, pollution, waterways further degraded, heavy transport and road use. These are negative impacts that the local community has to live with. The application includes the removal of wetland vegetation. Areas of wetland are dwindling in this country, they need protecting to conserve what little is left.

Consent comment:

I wish that the consent authority would remember that allowing pollution for profit does not fit into any intelligent proposal, and certainly not in a climate emergency. Bathurst Mines are not to be trusted. Please do not allow this application to be consented, and this dirty industry to continue.
