In 2019 Environment Canterbury made a Declaration of Climate Emergency. So did the

Council for the Kapiti Coast where I live. I may not be a neighbour of Bathurst's mine but I will be directly affected - we will all be directly affected, and our kids and grandkids - if we don't keep coal in the ground. It is strongly against the public interest of the whole country, and certainly the interests of Canterbury ratepayers, to damage the climate by burning coal in NZ to dry milk powder for export to places like China and India, or by exporting the coal itself to other countries which burn it. Do not let Barthurst or Fonterra tell you that they will offset carbon emissions by buying up our forestry land! As a country we need to reduce emissions AND plant trees - and most especially we need to KEEP COAL IN THE GROUND.
