I'm strongly opposed to the expansion of this mine for the following reasons:

1. The mine is primarily used to supply dairy processing plants in Canterbury. Canterbury already has more dairy production than the area can sustain without doing further damage to our water and the environment generally. Fonterra etc should be reducing their operations, and therefore will require less energy to operate.
