Submission to Ecan/Selwyn District Council re Resource Consent Application CON520

As per Public Notification of 21st March 2020 re Bathurst Coal Ltd

I, Evan Miles Frew, act as a Trustee for Avoca Trust, owner of land covered by Bathurst Coal Ltd's application. I am also a Director and Shareholder of Cairnridge Ltd, owner of land covered by the application

My submission is focused on the following four issues:

1. The actual area of land involved in the application.

The titles listed on the application cover a much larger area than is proposed to be mined. I draw your attention to attached map obtained from Edwina White, Bathurst Coal Ltd. The blue line defines the area where mining-related activities will take place. The red line inside this area is referred as 'pit shells' – this is the area where the coal extraction will take place. I support the application providing that all mining-related activity takes place <u>only</u> in the area within the blue line on the map. Thus, Cairnridge Ltd and any titles for land owned by Cairnridge Ltd are irrelevant and should be withdrawn from the application.

2. Land Reinstatement.

It is imperative that the applicant makes adequate provision for land reinstatement – the applicant has already begun reinstatement work on the mining site with about 12 ha grassed down in pasture. This is part of Bathurst Ltd's ongoing programme and much more will need to be done. My submission is that, given the scale of the operation, Bathurst Coal Ltd should be required to lodge a bond with the joint councils of \$1,000,000 to ensure that full reinstatement of the total area – to land contours suitable for forestry planting and harvesting - takes place on a timely basis.

3. Mining Footprint Restriction.

I am concerned about the total area of the mining-related activity at any given time and would submit that this area should never exceed 25ha

4. Road Upgrade

I submit that if this application is granted, Malvern Hills and Bush Gully Roads will require considerable upgrading to ensure safety for all road users. The cost of this should be borne by Selwyn District Council not Bathurst Coal Ltd.

In conclusion, subject to the conditions outlined above, Avoca Trust supports the consent application because there is no alternative energy resource currently available for Bathurst's clients in this area.
