Reasons comment:

I am concerned about the further impact of the mine on drinking water, local streams,

rivers and waterways. I am angry that Fonterra continues to use polluting coal in its South Island plants. When Fonterra built its enormous Darfield plant, they could have chosen to cover the roof with solar panels, but instead chose a dirty option. The expansion of the mine will further endanger threatened species such as the kowaro. Wetlands must be protected and left untouched, to protect native species of flora and fauna as they play a part in ensuring a healthy planet. Expansion of the mine to mine more coal will contribute to increasing the rapidity and severity of climate change. Expansion of the mine will have health and safety impacts on Darfield residents with more truck traffic likely. More truck traffic contributes to the rapidity and severity of climate change. This proposal to expand the Bathurst mine should be refused. We must make change now to protect the planet and all of our futures. It is clear that if we continue to burn fossil fuels, we can expect to endanger all of our futures.
