Hello there.

This is a submission for Bathurst Coal Ltd related to Canterbury Coal Mine.

- The coal mines from Canterbury Coal Mine is a typical sub-bituminous coal and it is has got a medium high calorific value with low sulphur content.
- This coal has been used not only for local dairy plants, but also used for a lot of local business in Canterbury region including hospitals, universities, factory processing heating, and horticultural plants. The combined usage except dairy plants is in the level of 10,000 tonnes per year.
- With this local coal, the coal mine provides much better security and certainty in supply.
- As the coal mine is close to the coal user, using this coal has significantly reduced the road transportation cost and the associated emissions comparing with getting coals from West Coast and/ or Southland.
- Due to its lower Sulphur content, the Canterbury coal is a ideal coal to be blended with other coal from West Coast and we can make good use of our resources.
