**Reasons comment:**

My opposition to these proposals are all on environmental grounds. At a very local level

the destruction of any further wetlands in this already highly modified area should be absolutely banned, particularly as this is habitat for the endangered mudfish. Any local discharge of contaminants into the air and the water should not be permitted for an operation that has at its heart a damaging effect on the global environment in terms of climate change. Destruction of further fragile, erosion prone land should also not be permitted for the same reason, it is a fundamentally outdated and backwards way of looking at our fragile landscape, and any decisions should be made with future generations in mind.
