## Declaration of interest register

The guiding principle for declarations in the interest's register is set out in the Members' Code of Conduct, which states:

*"Honesty and Integrity – Members should not place themselves in situations where their honesty and integrity may be questioned, should not behave improperly and should on all occasions avoid the appearance of such behaviour"*

In addition, the Local Authorities (Members' Interests) Act 1968 is concerned with members' financial and non-financial interests. The Office of the Auditor General notes a conflict of interest can arise when: *"A member's or official's duties or responsibilities to a public entity could be affected by some other interest or duty that the member or official may have."*<sup>1</sup>

Keeping a declaration of interest register (both financial and non-financial) allows the Council to identify and manage a conflict of interest when it arises. The register should also include any such interest(s) held by a Tumu Taiao's partner or spouse.

Guidance on conflicts of interest is included in Councillors' Code of Conduct, which provides that the register should be reviewed annually, and in the Office of the Auditor-General's Good Practice Guide.

If there is any doubt as to whether or not a particular course of action (including a decision to take no action) raises a conflict of interest, then the Member should seek guidance from the Chief Executive *immediately*.


The information in the completed declarations will be publicly available on Council's website.
