Reasons comment:

We have concerns for the health and well being of the residents and ourselves as we will be at home a lot during the operating hours of the quarry due to our

shift work.

Consent comment:

Take in to consideration the increased risk to ground water contamination, even though the report considers the potential and actual adverse effects likely to be minor. Also the increase to noise emissions even though not high, they will likely be constant. At present the noise generated is only intermittent. Air pollution is also of concern, particularly high, in a hot north-westerly. These potential risks will have an adverse effect on the health and well being of the local residents. Quarries next to residential areas don't go well
