- -Separate to this, I'd like to see increased and targeted education for owners of fireplaces in Christchurch about how to use it efficiently and respectfully Often my neighbours house floods mine in smoke which I suspect to be generated from wet and cold wood as well as general rubbish.
- -There are a lot of empty buses driving around Christchurch. Perhaps a on demand service can replace underutilised routes and off-peak times as appropriate. This would reduce our carbon emissions, and likely provide for better and more use of Public transport.
