When using the My way buses, you have to book an hour and a half ahead of time just to make it to your appointment. Because when I have been on them it usually takes an hour to get to your destination, because they have to pick up and drop off people at various locations around town. Upon going home, you usually end up going to the other side of town to pick people up or drop off, before you end up going to your home location. So this takes much longer than going on the Link bus, which is a much better bus ride. You can wait for the Link bus 5 mins before being picked up and you can be at your destination within 10-20mins. There's more room on the Link bus, and its better for prams, pushchairs, walkers, or wheelchairs. The longest I've had to wait for the My way bus is 28 mins and thats not at peak times also. This wait time is far too long. Also you can have more shopping items on the Link bus, cause there's room, whereas you are only allowed 2 bags for the My way bus. I've seen people buying a bike in a box from the Warehouse and gone on the Link with it. U wouldnt be able to do that on a My way bus. I've had to stand in the pouring rain on the street that is back of the Warehouse to wait for a My way bus, where as another person was waiting in the bus shelter. We could of been waiting at the bus shelter too. My son's cellphone doesn't even get the app on his phone, so he has had to use my phone.
