Water and Land portfolio comments:

My comments in the next section apply to Water and Land portfolio, and affects freshwater resilience, healthy waterways, and our stewardship.

Air Quality, Transport and Urban Development portfolio comments:

Creating more impervious surface through urbanisation creates larger quantities of stormwater, that are heated by pavement and pick up inertia as it moves along accessways before discharging diffuse pollution into waterways. We must concentrate on using alternatives to conventional pavement, such as pervious concrete or other pervious surfaces, that are strong enough to withstand pedestrian, bicycle, or vehicular traffic. In no way should we keep using asphalt, because this pavement leaches polyaromatic hydrocarbons into our environment. This option appears to be the cheapest, but in fact it has a shorter lifespan that conventional concrete or pervious concrete, and more money is spent maintaining/replacing asphalt than if concrete were used in the first place.
