They have a huge vested interest in intensive farming, so how can the general public be confident that they will be truly protect our land, water, braided rivers etc. rather than be an enabler for the agricultural industry. In its passive stance over the non- notified consent renewal process for the MHV irrigation scheme, it would suggest that the Tuia partnership/leadership model is not truly honouring its vision or guiding principles.
