As a resident of Elloughton Village and President of the residents committee I am writing to you with these major safety concerns of all residents and family members who need to use the round about at our entrance. That is Old north road, Pages road, Selwyn Street and exit from Elloughton Village also Elloughton Gardens rest home.

There is a very large number of older folk in this area with another village next door plus school children from two schools near by.

Many of the traffic neither slow down or give way to their right as is part of our road code.

We so far have not yet had a fatality but some VERY CLOSE calls

Do we have to wait until something happens like a death or serious injury before something is done.

Maybe Flashing signs or Slow Down Elderly People and school children ahead.

I have spoken to Senior Sergeant Dave Hinde about this dangerous situation and has said this is out of their jurisdiction and it is a Council Problem

My husband and I also spoke to Peter Burt our City Councillor for transport and roads who asked to put this Very Serious Problem in writing.

Our village manager supports our efforts to have this addressed and rectified Joan and Tony Ruston
