Water and Land portfolio comments:

Pleasing to see some progress on improving water quality, but much more needs to be done. Water quality has continued deteriorating over the last two decades at least. The horse has well and truly bolted since the early 2000's when the Water Rights Trust (of which I was a trustee for a period) made regular submissions to ECan asking for a moratorium on dairy conversions. There is now new Danish research suggesting proposed nitrate levels are still far too high. I would like nitrate polluters to pay full costs to address these issues, and I think permissible nitrate levels should be reduced to the Danish study amounts of 0.87 mg/l. ECan should also take much stronger steps to lobby central government, as well as step up monitoring and particularly enforcement which has always been woefully under-resourced and given far too little emphasis.

Biodiversity and Biosecurity portfolio comments:

I support ECan stepping up and taking a lead on these issues and working collaboratively with others.

Climate Change and Community Resilience portfolio comments:

I welcome the climate education funding in option 1, and would like it to emphasise the need for collective action and systemic change, rather than individual consumer changes.

Air Quality, Transport and Urban Development portfolio comments:

I would like to see more serious consideration of light rail, even if it is just protecting future corridors at this stage.

We need to better protect valuable soils from housing development.

Regional and Strategic Leadership portfolio comments:

It is apparent that we do not have systems that are able to rapidly adapt to changing information - eg climate change, science around nitrates, deteriorating water quality. ECan needs to give this serious attention. A good example is the Hinds Recharge renewal consent which should definitely be notified because of the very serious implications for public health which have recently been publicised. I support rates rises to cover increasing demands for action particularly on water quality and climate change, although I am disappointed that once again the public is being asked to pay to clean up pollution which should have been paid for by the polluters (particularly dairy farms). I strongly support changing to an STV voting system at the 2022 election.

I support more spending on sorting out Mckenzie basin conservation issues.
