Ecan'snew protection and regeneration programme, Me Uru Rakau, for priority ecological catchments, such as Whakaraupo Lyttelton Harbour, is an important initiative to enable the rehabilitation and increase in biodiversity in such areas. Funding of the Whaka Ora Healthy Harbour project must continue as it is already proving very successful and has lots of community support from groups around the Harbour who have been involved in providing hundreds of volunteer hours doing such things as riperian planting to improve water quality.

Youth are the future and so investment in Enviroschools and other such projects is very important to provide the people who will have the skills and enthusiasm to look after the environment in coming years.

A contestable fund to support community projects such as the volunteer work done by the Cass Bay community and Reserves Management Committee is essential for the ongoing work done locally to

improve the environment and increase biodiversity to happen.

Changing the colour of the buses seems to be an unnecessary waste of money when the transport budget is so stretched. This has made travel by bus very difficult for the vision impaired as they can no longer distinguish which bus is approach, especially when several buses arrive at once.

Water and Land portfolio comments:

The Whaka Ora Healthy Harbour project is an excellent example of how to protect and restore priority aquatic ecosystems and habitats to bring back mahinga Kai and improve water quality and flow through such things as riperian planting. It should therefore continue to be funded so that projects such as that started last year at Steadfast in Cass Bay, Lyttelton can continue and communities can be encouraged to take part in stewardship of land and water.

Monitoring and data collection projects, such as that being done by Students from Frontiers Abroad, are essential for sound restoration outcomes.

Biodiversity and Biosecurity portfolio comments:

Cass Bay Residents Association has promoted our community becoming active participants in the Pest Free Banks Peninsula programme as well as the Cass Bay Reserves Management Committee having weed species eradication working bees each year. Without such actions our other work to improve biodiversity and encourage native flora and fauna back into our Bay would be significantly less successful. We would like towards Steadfast Reserve becoming a Pest Free Reserve. It is already fully fenced by the historical military fence which could be upgraded to suit this purpose and we are already trapping in the area.

We have been planting natives in our reserves for over 30 years and have started to see the return of kereru and tui. Having a contestable fund to support local groups like ours is vital for this volunteer work to continue and Me Uru Rakau to happen.

We support such initiatives as "Jobs for Nature" to make this work possible as not all work can be done on a voluntary basis and this will significantly increase the speed and success of a lot of projects.

Climate Change and Community Resilience portfolio comments:

We are all aware of the increasing effects of climate change and it is essential that community resilience is encouraged and steps taken to mitigate the problem. Civil Defence has a vital part to play in preparing and educating people in these matters as well as being able to respond in time of crisis.

Air Quality, Transport and Urban Development portfolio comments:

The current us service in Cass Bay does not meet the needs of our community. Having only 3 buses early in the morning and between 4.30 and 6 during the week means that locals who want to travel to town for anything other than work are forced to tack their cars. We have no service at all at the weekends when people from the city could use the bus to travel to both Cass Bay, Rapaki and Corsair Bay to go to the beach, which currently causes considerable traffic problems on hot days for both parking and

queues. Locals would find a bus to Lyttelton most useful on a Saturday morning so they could get to the Farmers market and back without having to find take their cars especially as their is limited parking spaces.

Although our children live in the Cashmere High School Zone there is no school bus or suitable bus service to get them there so most parents have to drive them there, which is both inconvenient and bad for the environment. This matter needs to be addressed as soon as possible.

We support the continuation of the Timaru trial of "My Way On Demand" as this might also work for suburbs like ours if it was extended.
