Climate Change and Community Resilience portfolio comments:

I would like to see a by-law introduced that if land is being cleared for development, even a single section in residential Christchurch, that if all the trees are removed, then at least 30% are replaced. There are sections being cleared around town that have old established trees, architects are clever and plans could be made around the existing trees, which are normally only on the boundary of the property anyway. This would encourage developers and private land owners to consider the impact of the removal of established trees. The replacement trees should be established trees, like from the little big tree company, not young saplings. And if it is impossible for the developer to replace trees on that section, then they pay for trees to be planted somewhere else in the area, like an area set aside by council for a replanting project.
