I am generally opposed to any flat rate charges when proportional charges are an option. The proposed changes to the UAGC seem like they would be inconsequential to any property owner but it still seems unfair to hit those with less with the same charges as those with more.

While it might be more "fair" to spread those costs out over time for those that might not see their benefits it doesn't seem necessary considering the relatively small amount it would offset for any one rate payer. What's a few \$10s of dollars for the average rate payer?

The difference to a single rate payer is small, but the potential amount of interest paid over the course of the loan may be large compared to the year 1 offset.

Rates are going to go up over time and paying off interest on top of those increases is only going to make things worse.

If the loans were for major investment into new revenue streams that would actually reduce rates in the future I would support them. But borrowing for operating expenditure is not what I want to see.
