Water and Land portfolio comments:

The timeframe for the reparation of land and water quality needs to be changed to 5-10 years not 30. Farmers can well afford to cover the costs involved without making urban ratepayers who have lost their clean waterways pay farmers compensation for the exploitation and pollution of these resources

Air Quality, Transport and Urban Development portfolio comments:

I am concerned at the level of urban development in Selwyn and the area of land proposed to be developed in the future. The village atmosphere in Lincoln and Tai Tapu need to be preserved and not be swallowed up in one huge band of settlement wrapping right around Christchurch from Tai Tapu to Kirwee and Darfield. These villages are steeped in local history and should not be lost in a characterless urban sprawl. We support bio-diversity and should also support diversity in human habitation

Regional and Strategic Leadership portfolio comments:

It's time ECan stopped being a tool for the farmers and represented all of the (mostly wage-earning) ratepayers who pay ECan's wages, and those who will be the future ratepayers. Any decisions regarding the use of water and possible pollution of waterways and aquifers need to be made only after consultation and agreement by the majority of ratepayers. It seems Ecan has forgotten what real democracy means. If democracy had been the process of government in Canterbury all these past 30 years the quality of our waterways would not be in such a parlous state.
