It is important that we hear what you would like to keep in the plan, what you think should be removed, and anything that you think we have missed?

I would like to keep the majority of the Option 1 plan, with the following small changes:

- \* I would prefer for the costs to be more progressively applied, by which I mean no increase in the UAGC but instead a larger increase in the General Rate. This avoids burdening lower income households with the same cost increases as better off households. A cost of a couple of dollars per week is much more significant to some than to others.
- \* I would like to see a way to manage public transport costs for individual households. At present if a typical household of 3-5 people wishes to use the bus to get to school / work, it can cost in the region of \$15-\$20 per say which is high enough that it incentivises use of private vehicles. I would like to see

something like a "household cap" of say \$10 per day which would remain lower than the petrol costs of a typical commute and school run.
