I would like to comment on the response needed if our current climate emergency is to be taken seriously. Land use specifically in Canterbury is resulting in net soil carbon depletion, soil erosion, biodiversity loss with vast areas of land achieving little. Furthermore, the efforts to restore natives is requiring strategic thinking as dry spells become more persistent with climate change. However, the approaches needed may not be popular with locals, much like the level of hostility that Hugh Wilson received in restoring the Hinewai reserve. These attitudes still persist in the community, and only ECAN has the ability to know and understand the facts behind restoration efforts, educate the public and take steps to legitimise and support restorations.
