The three biggest areas that ECAN can have a positive impact on climate action, are land use, public transport and water usage. We need to ensure agricultural usage of land isn't privatizing the profit and publicizing the environmental costs. This also goes for water usage. Currently, organizations that are in breach of ECAN consents don't always fairly pay for the cost of the cleanup, or pay a fine that is

large enough to deter the same behavior. We absolutely need more enforcement, and the penalties need to be appropriately matched to the cost of remedial work and to prevent profit from being realized despite consent breaking.

With regard to public transport, we need to continue to encourage active transport, invest in high-quality public transport, and encourage electric vehicle adoption where possible.
