Fire risk has not been covered. You have rightly pointed out that climate change will lead to hotter and drier conditions, particularly on the East Coast. Pine and eucalyptus plantations are numerous, and in many cases are dangerously close to settlements, presenting a very real fire risk. We know that fires are becoming far more numerous, and spread very quickly in the dry conditions. Further plantations are planned. There must be planning for fire risk by replanting with more fire resistant native trees. This requires careful management where trees were originally planted to lessen erosion and rock fall.

I don't see enough detail in your report, and would like to know what serious action is being planned around nitrates in the water and the huge amount of irrigation being used to irrigate overstocked dairy farms. We have lost access to clean water and our rivers are drying up and becoming eutrophied and toxic. Urgent action is needed, and support for farmers to move towards regenerative farming. Bus routes in Christchurch are inadequate, particularly since Ecan has cut some and re-routed others. To get people out of cars, reducing congestion, emissions and improving air quality, we need better bus routes, timetables and buses need to be free. Central Government should be supporting this.
