Water and Land portfolio comments:

Fresh thinking, plans and regulatory framework for healthy waterways is vital, along with environmental monitoring, and zone committees, partnerships and community participation and activity

Biodiversity and Biosecurity portfolio comments:

I am thrilled to to see this whole proposal that includes braided river revival, wetlands, regionwide tree planting (Me uru Rākau), regional parks, and meeting biosecurity requirements including increased wallaby and wilding conifer control.

Climate Change and Community Resilience portfolio comments:

I strongly support each line item in this portfolio and am pleased to see Ecan's proposal to take a leadership role in our response to climate change, community resilience and flood and river resilience - as well as managing the coastal environment. Contaminated land, hazardous substances and waste is another pressing issue that needs action and funding.

Air Quality, Transport and Urban Development portfolio comments:

Public transport is a hard portfolio to get right. I support Ecan's efforts to find the right formula for increased network coverage, a sustainable service, public acceptance and uptake in order to reduce carbon emissions, road congestion and expensive highway building and maintenance. Integrating urban land use and regional transport is also an important priority.

Regional and Strategic Leadership portfolio comments:

Good strategic planning, sound data to underpin decision making and foster an informed community, partnerships, community engagement, environmental education and work to identify new income sources all underpin the democratic process. I am encouraged by the diversity of collaborations entered into by Ecan - in particular the Tuia relationship with Ngai Tahu's Papatipu Rūnanga and the Youth Rōpū. It is also good to see local government collaboration through the Mayoral Forum and the Greater Christchurch Partnership.

I think it is an investment in the future. The rates will rise anyway under both Options 1 and 2 and there is not a huge difference between the two, but the difference in outcomes will be significant. I also notice that Option 1 attracts just under 2M more in Grants than Option 2.

For so long we have ignored environmental degradation in Canterbury, and climate change is only adding to the need for urgent action. I am encouraged that we have this opportunity to take quite strong and meaningful action. I think we have to do this!
