Climate Change and Community Resilience portfolio comments:

In addition to the measures proposed to adapt to climate change, ECan needs to allocate resources to mitigating climate change and help the country reduce emissions as fast as possible, 50% by 2030. These measures can include helping farmers to reduce emissions and help Christchurch and other urban areas cut emissions from transport. More resources need to be allocated towards the transition to a carbon-neutral region!

Air Quality, Transport and Urban Development portfolio comments:

Public transport needs to become a more viable option. Personally, I find short distances (10 minutes bus drive to CBD) too expensive (and instead usually bike) and longer distances take too long on a bus. Maybe the option for light rail should be investigated. People living in similar size cities in Europe don't own cars and are able to take trams everywhere. In the long term this is what Christchurch should strive towards as well.

In my research on the transport transition in urban areas, the need for experimentation and low-cost trials in single neighbourhoods was key factor in changing people's travel behaviour. Similar projects as Innovative Streets should be explored in terms of public transport. Or experiment with 'Mobility as a Service' (SAAS) or other transformational projects to support people transition away from personal car use.
