Buses need to have higher frequency and longer hours. I live on the route. This only runs hourly at weekends, which is much too infrequent to be usable. It should be half-hourly at weekends and ideally every 20minutes during the week. I wanted to use the bus to get back from town on Friday night but the last bus is at 21:30. It should be 22:30 (like on Saturday night) or preferably later still. The bike racks on the buses are very good.
