Water and Land portfolio comments:

The delay in reinstating the optimum flow (10.9cms DOC) in the Ashburton river has been unacceptable. Consent review 'solutions' from surface water take to 40 metres deep ground water is not acceptable as it still has an effect on the river especially in dry periods. The priority should be to reinstate the rivers

Biodiversity and Biosecurity portfolio comments:

Many are dismayed by the weed ridden state of the smaller braided rivers in Canterbury. Thousands of Southern Black Backed gulls in the Ashburton deter the other braided river species year after year. Control is a priority.

Infestation of grey willow in previously unaffected areas in the upper Ashburton is extremely disappointing.

The proliferation of wallabies should never been allowed to happen. Their control must be a priority I support a well funded and effective biodiversity and biosecurity portfolio

Climate Change and Community Resilience portfolio comments:
