The proposed budgets are not prudent and in my view are irresponsible. Rate rases of 10% are manageable for communities at a stretch. Focus on core activities and scrap the bloated unnecessary policies.

As mentioned above, government must be forced to recognise the 60m local ratepayers have invested developing current plans.
