The Temuka and Districts project Trust has been going for a number of years and helps run and manage community-based projects. We apply for funding from various areas and manage and account for the funds to ensure the best value for money can be achieved.

We were interested to hear about, and are in favour of the new environmental initiative from Environment Canterbury. We fully support the new Community Action Fund, as any support to build capacity and action for local environmental projects has to be a good thing.

The Projects Trust is currently looking for funding for a Local Temuka River planting project that will be done on consultation with local groups and iwi. We are wanting to look at plantings that will enhance our local waterways, improve water quality, increase native bird/wildlife activity on our rivers and in the process educate those involved about the complex issues surrounding management of our waterways.

In consultation with local iwi and ECAN we would like to target specific riverbed areas with species specific planting that will bring long term benefits to the ecosystem. We see this a being a starting point to a long term strategy of local waterway improvement and have support of our local Community Board and Council to achieve this.
