I Gregory Rowland Wilson of wish to reject and or oppose the imposition of a swing mooring annual fee towards removal of wrecks/abandoned vessels from swing moorings at a cost of \$57.50 p.a. as recorded on page 268 of the Draft Long Term Plan. Please refer to the second item under "Swing mooring charges".
