

Temporary Reservation Certificate, issued pursuant to:
Canterbury Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016
Clauses 12 and 32.

Name of holder: Firework Professionals, Magenta Wilde
Period: From: 1700 on 22 nd Jul 2021 to 2100 on 24 th Jul 2021; or Until revoked by the Harbourmaster.
Reserved Area: Exclusion Zone, Area in front of Naval point yacht club stretching 175m south from the old marina and 100m west of the shoreline.
Map attached: Yes/No
Purpose: Exclusion of all unauthorized vessels within safety zone at Naval Point (as per map) to allow safe operation of Fireworks Display. Uplift of 5 knot rule within 200m of shore or structure for the purpose of enforcement of exclusion zone, or in case of emergency.
Reservation: No vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area as listed above except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, the certificate holder or his delegate.
Conditions:
Publication of notice of Reservation: Public notification of exclusion zone in local press and social media, signage to be posted at Naval Point boat ramps.
Notice of Reservation to be: Displayed on: All support vessels Displayed by: Magenta Wilde (or delegate) . Removed by: Magenta Wilde (or delegate); or the Harbourmaster
A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: Magenta Wilde and all support vessel skippers
Safety conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Formal safety briefing to be given to safety boat skippers prior to event.2. All support vessels must adhere to maritime rule 22 (lighting).3. All support vessels must always be in direct contact with Fireworks control.4. All support vessels must be skippered by a suitably experienced / qualified person.5. All breaches by support vessels of Maritime Rule Part 91 or Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016 (such as 5 knot rule) to be logged and reported to the Harbourmaster at the conclusion of the event.6. Any breach of the exclusion zone by unauthorised vessel must be logged and fireworks display paused.
Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: Conditions above are not met.
