

PUBLIC NOTICE

CANTERBURY REGIONAL COUNCIL (NGĀI TAHU REPRESENTATION) BILL

1. This is notice of the intention of the Canterbury Regional Council (trading as Environment Canterbury) to promote a local Bill to achieve enactment of the above Bill.
2. The objects of the Bill are:
 - 2.1 to provide for mana whenua representation on the Council by empowering Te Rūnanga o Ngāi Tahu to appoint up to 2 members of the Council in addition to the elected members;
 - 2.2 to ensure that, once appointed, those members have the same status as elected members for all purposes; and
 - 2.3 to make consequential provisions.
