The residents of Diamond Harbour and the surrounding bays are frequently left off the councils plan and miss out of benefits the rest of Christchurch receives simply because we're easily forgotten. Option 2 actually benefits my community. Many elderly folk in Diamond Harbour feel cut off and isolated as driving into the city gets beyond their capabilities (roading issues are a significant factor), and have to rely on the generosity of strangers or volunteers simply to get them to the city to shop once a fortnight. The current exorbitant price of the ferry (and the bus drivers frequent refusal to accept passengers tickets from the ferry and forcing them to buy a second ticket just for the bus) makes the whole rigmarole too much for our most vulnerable. As there are plans to install a more accessible jetty at Diamond Harbour the fares should also become more accessible. We are an environment conscious community and are aware of the harm driving into town does for our planet, however, with expensive bus fares, and unmaintained buses, taking public transport is hardly an appealing prospect. Reducing the ferry fare will also contribute to more people traveling to Diamond harbour and support in our local businesses. Please listen to the communities you represent for once and don't just pick the plan you've already decided you like, as you have done so often in the past.
