Several years back when consultation was made on bus fares I suggested having a hop-on hop-off fare structure similar to transport in Wellington and Auckland. The response was that the council was looking at such a fare structure for the future, however it appears nothing has come of this. Most modern cities around the world use this type of fare structure, and it means people will actually pay a sensible amount based on the distance of their journey. It makes no sense that from Prebbleton I could take a bus all the way to New Brighton for less than if I took the bus 8km up the road to Lincoln. I understand the flat fare would fix this, however this would just mean people who are travelling shorter distances will be subsidising those who take longer trips. It seems to make more sense to use this method and I would like to know why the council haven't considered it.
