Recommended change to the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan (CLWRP) pursuant to Clause 20A of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA)

Clause 20A of Schedule 1 to the RMA states:

“A local authority may amend, without using the process in this schedule, an operative policy statement or plan to correct any minor errors.”

The following amendment to correct a minor error is recommended to be made to the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan. The recommended insertion is shown in underlined text.

Location in Plan	Recommended Correction	Reason for Correction
Rule 5.79	The discharge of contaminants and water ... or into <u>or onto</u> land is a permitted activity, provided the following conditions are met: ...	The CLWRP (as made operative on 1 September 2015 following the resolution of all appeals) contained the words “or onto” in Rule 5.79. This rule was amended by PC4, the words “or onto” were not removed by this Plan Change, no other Plan Changes have been notified to include amendments to Rule 5.79. The words “or onto” have been erroneously removed from the operative Plan.

It is considered appropriate to use Clause 20A to Schedule 1 of the RMA to amend the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan for the following reasons:


- This alteration has been recommended to address a minor error in the Plan.
- The correction of Rule 5.79 reflects the intended outcome in the Council’s decision on Plan Change 4 to the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan.
