

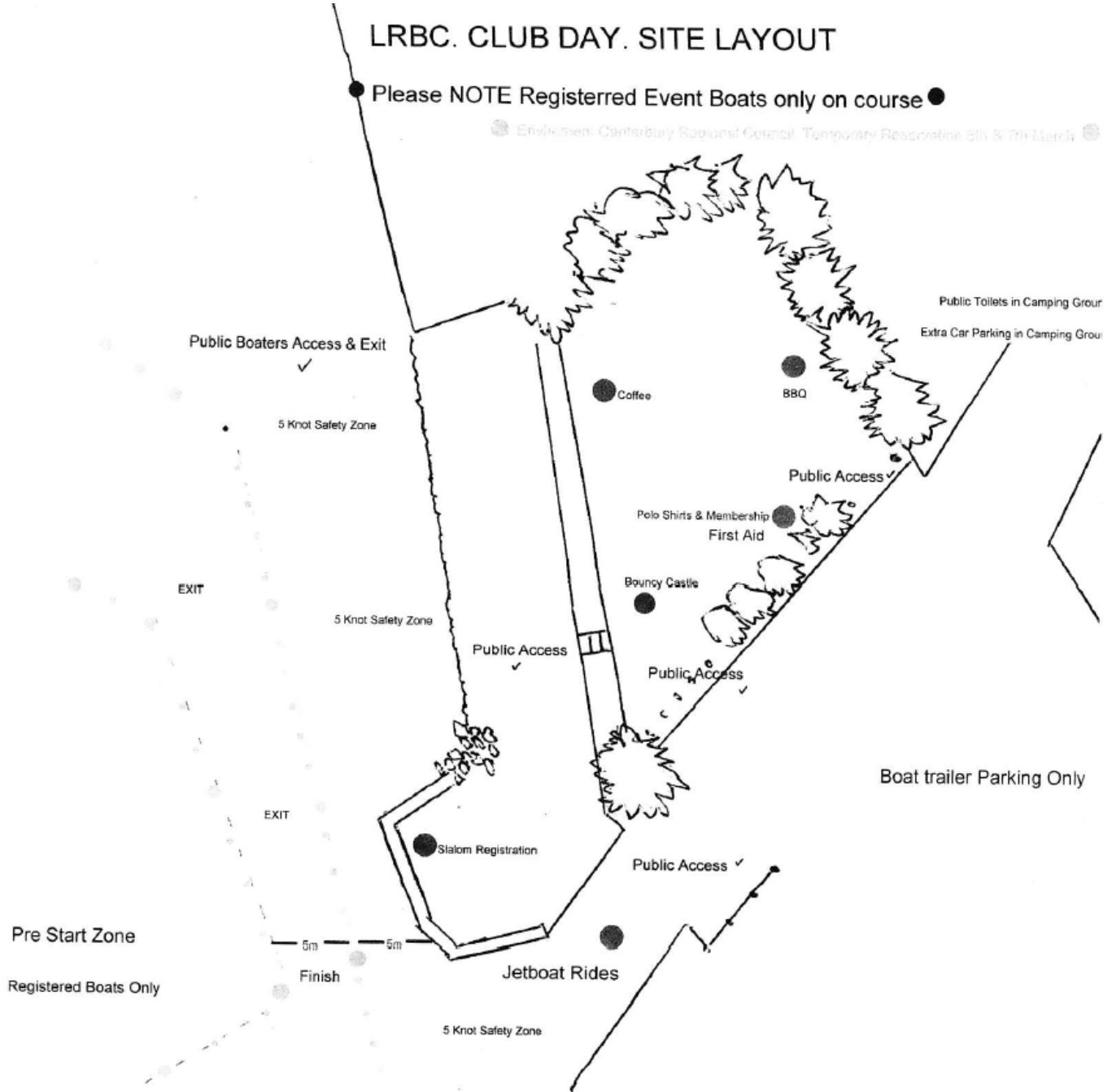
Temporary Reservation Certificate, issued pursuant to:  
Canterbury Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016  
Clauses 8, 12 and 32.

Name of holder: Little Rakaia Boating Club Inc, Graeme Patterson
Period: From: 0700 to 1700 on 9 <sup>th</sup> Feb 2023 to 12 <sup>th</sup> Feb 2023; and 2 <sup>nd</sup> Mar 2023 to 5 <sup>th</sup> Mar 2023; or Until revoked by the Harbourmaster.
Reserved Area: Reserved area Little River Huts Lagoon Exemption – Speed uplift to exceed 5 kts within the Lagoon as per attached map
Map attached: <b>Yes/No</b>
Purpose: Exclusion of all unauthorised vessels within course zone in Little Rakaia Huts Lagoon as stated above to allow safe operation of the Slalom Course Club Day Fundraiser. Uplift of 5 knot rule within 200m of shore or structure, uplift of the 5 knot rule within 50m of another competitor (NS Bylaw 2016 clause 8 (a) (b), or in case of emergency.
Reservation: <b>No vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area as listed above except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, the certificate holder or his delegate.</b> <b>Uplift of 5 knot rule within 200m of shore or structure, uplift of the 5 knot rule within 50m of another competitor (NS Bylaw 2016 clause 8 (a) (b)), or in case of emergency.</b>
Conditions: Publication of notice of Reservation: Public notification of exclusion zone on relevant print and social media. Community Board consultation (provided)
Notice of Reservation to be: Displayed on: At event HQ, Boat Ramp and all support vessels Displayed by: Graeme Patterson <b>(or delegate)</b> . Removed by: Graeme Patterson <b>(or delegate); or the Harbourmaster</b>
A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: Graeme Patterson and all support vessel skippers
Safety conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Formal safety briefing to be given to all competitors and safety boat skippers prior to event.</li><li>2. Safety plan supplied for the event to be adhered to.</li><li>3. Any incidents, accidents, or close calls to be reported to the Harbourmaster and any relevant authority.</li><li>4. Upon a breach of the reserved area by an unauthorised vessel, all event vessels are to revert to Maritime Rules 22 and 91 (Collision Regulations and 5 knot rules)</li></ol>
Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: <b>Conditions above are not met.</b>
