Good afternoon

As per Commissioner Minute 3, a late submission was received by Council regarding the Woodstock Quarries resource consent application. The submission was accepted by the Commissioner and the opportunity was provided by the Commissioner for the Council reporting Officers to file additional evidence (or reports) in relation to the issues raised by the submission.

Accordingly, I have considered the submission and whether additional evidence or reports should be provided.

In reviewing the submission it is noted that matters of noise, nuisance and amenity, including on adjoining andowners, have already been considered as part of the section 42A report. Stormwater and contamination were also assessed in the report but it was stated that these were matters more appropriately assessed in a detailed manner by the reporting Officer for Environment Canterbury.

With regards to the recently received submission, I understand that general comments will be provided by the Environment Canterbury Reporting Officer with specialist comment where required. The provision of comment from the Environment Canterbury Reporting Planner regarding the issues raised in the submission also aligns with the approach taken with the 42A reports.

On this basis, no further evidence or reports are submitted by the Waimakariri District Council with regards to those matters raised in the submission of Ms Narbey.
