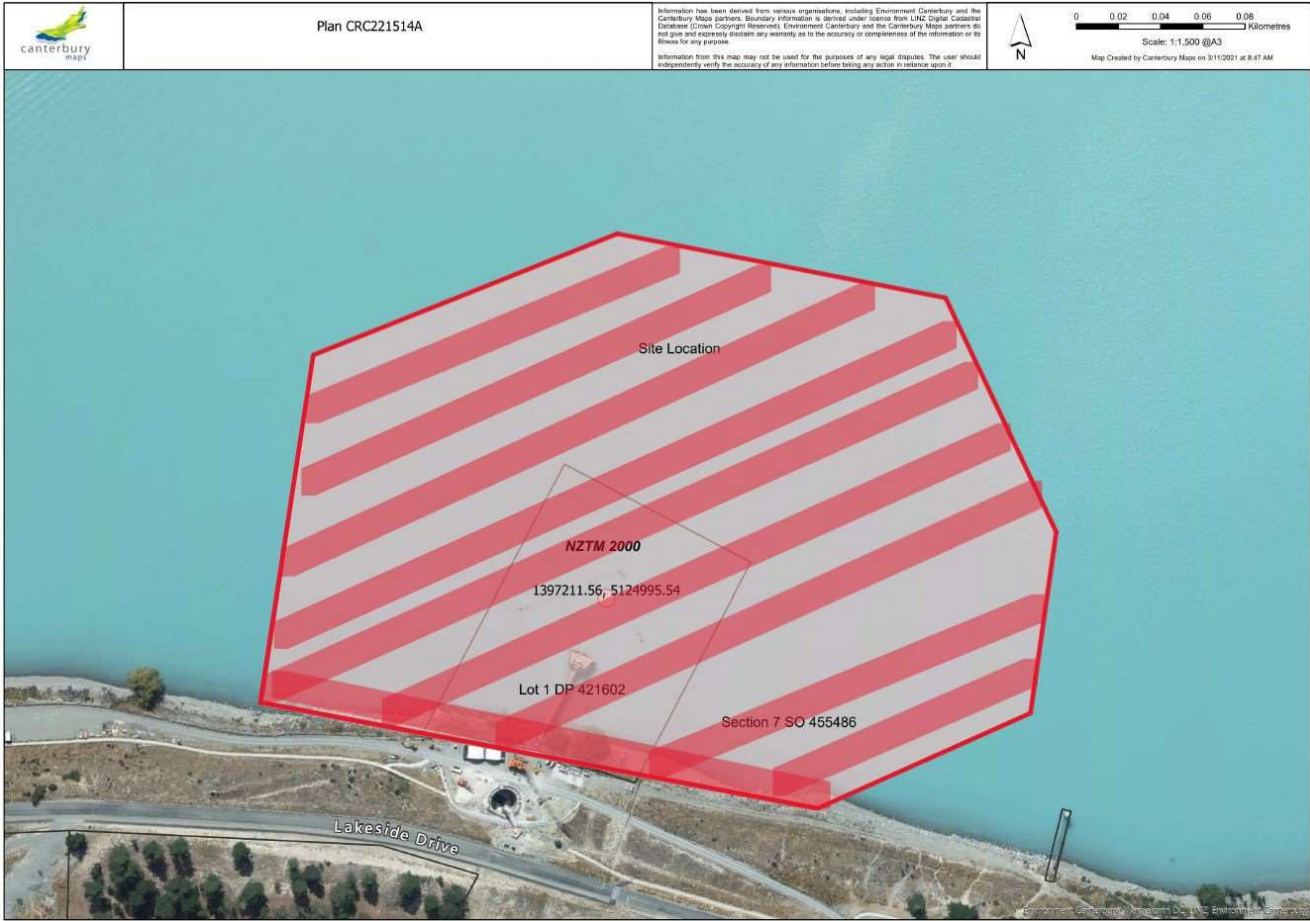


Temporary Reservation Certificate, issued pursuant to:  
Canterbury Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016  
Clauses 12 and 32.



<b>Name of holder:</b> Genesis Energy Ltd
<b>Period:</b> From: 0001 on 4th September 2023 to 2359 on 30th September 2024; or until revoked be Harbourmaster
<b>Reserved Area:</b> Takapō/Lake Tekapo – Area around intake at southern end of lake. See shaded area on attached map.
<b>Map attached:</b> Yes/No
<b>Purpose:</b> To allow for installation of a new safety boom surrounding the Takapō intake.
<b>Reservation:</b> No vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area as listed above except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, the certificate holder or their delegate, or the Harbourmaster.
<b>Conditions:</b>
<b>Publication of notice of Reservation:</b> Notification to known affected groups; notifications on appropriate websites and social media; notices at known boat ramps and key access points.
<b>Notice of Reservation to be:</b> <b>Displayed at:</b> As above. <b>Displayed by:</b> Anna Jessup (or delegate) 027 270 3224 <b>Removed by:</b> Anna Jessup (or delegate); or the Harbourmaster
<b>A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by:</b> The site manager/supervisor.
<b>Safety conditions:</b> As per submitted safety plan, including, but not limited to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. PFDs must be worn accordance with Maritime Rules Part 91 and the Canterbury Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw - 2016.</li><li>2. A printed map of the reserved area must be posted at all launch ramps in the area.</li><li>3. No vessels shall exceed 5 knots within the reserved area except when responding to an emergency.</li><li>4. This reservation is only active when works are being conducted.</li><li>5. Notification of working days must be sent through to Harbourmaster as far in advance as feasible prior to commencing.</li></ol>
<b>Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if:</b> Conditions above are not met.
