Evaluation of Tactical Response Model trials

- Evidence Based Policing Centre (EBPC) has produced an independent evaluation of the TRM trial.
- Evaluation ran from January 1, 2022 to 30 June 2022 in the four trial districts Northland, Counties Manukau, Waikato and Central.

The trial showed that each component of the TRM produces safety benefits, but the greatest impact happens when it operates as a safety system.







What will be new for Canterbury under TRM?

- Offender Prevention Tactical Team (OPT, formally PTT): supports investigative work to execute search warrants and apprehend Staff Safety Persons of Interest (SSPOI). Includes Investigative staff, AOS Tactical staff and Tactical Intel staff. They can also redeploy to critical incidents when approved.
- 2-up Tactical Dog Teams (TDTs): dog handler and AOS-qualified member with full tactical options, including a 40mm less-than-lethal option. Provides specialist capability to support frontline response and enhance safety.
- DCC: operates 24/7 supporting frontline deployment and staff safety including managing rural and dog callouts, and double crewing for all staff starting shift after 2100.
- **Daily Staff Safety Briefings:** led by DCC, focused on frontline risk and SSPOI. Three times daily for frontline staff across the district.
- Tactical Safety Training: hybrid model of PITT and FSED, currently being trialled in Canterbury.
