

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Plan Change 7 to the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan – to be made partially operative

At a Council meeting held on 16 August 2023, the Canterbury Regional Council (Environment Canterbury) approved Plan Change 7 to the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan, and in accordance with Clause 20 of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991 resolved to make Plan Change 7 partially operative from 1 September 2023.

### Plan Change 7

The Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan is the statutory framework for the management of land and freshwater resources within the Canterbury region. Plan Change 7 comprises three parts:

- Part A of Plan Change 7 is an “Omnibus” change
- Part B of Plan Change 7 primarily relates to the Orari-Temuka-Opihi-Pareora sub-region
- Part C of Plan Change 7 primarily relates to the Waimakariri sub-region.

Plan Change 7 also amends the Canterbury Land and Water Regional Plan map series (the planning maps).

Plan Change 7 is being made partially operative. The parts relating to forestry are currently subject to a legal challenge. All the other parts of the Plan are being made operative.
