The agenda was dealt with in the following order.

**1. Apologies Ngā Whakapāha**

There were apologies received from Annabelle Hasselman, Oscar Bloom and Amber Moke for absence. There was an apology from Councillor Byrnes for early departure.

### **3. Christchurch West Melton Water Management Zone Funding Applications**

The workshop began with presentations from the following applicants:

- Horotane Valley Planting Project (*see minutes attachment A*).
- The Avon-Heathcote Estuary Ihutai Trust.
  - The Committee noted that the trust carries out successful education programs with students from a wide variety of different universities and high schools.
- Te Tuna Tāone (*see minutes attachment B*).
  - The Committee noted the time spent and the activities and objectives achieved by the project.
  - The Committee inquired what portion of their budget is funded by the Sustainability Fund grant.
- Styx Mill Living Laboratory Trust (*see minutes attachment C*).
- Port Hills Park Trust (*see minutes attachment D*).

The Committee thanked the applicants for taking the time to make a presentation. The applicants then left the workshop.

The Committee discussed the funding applications, noting that the projects which impacted sediment and erosion were in line with its goals.

The Committee then discussed how much each potential applicant might receive and noted that these selections were hypothetical and did not represent a definitive direction or decision.

- Stormwater Superhero trailer - \$6,000
- Port Hills Park Trust - \$26,500
- Horotane Valley Planting Project - \$8,000
- The Avon-Heathcote Estuary Ihutai Trust - \$5,000
- Te Tuna Tāone - \$15,000
- In River Clean - \$9,500
- ESC Sharing Practical Knowledge - \$5,000
