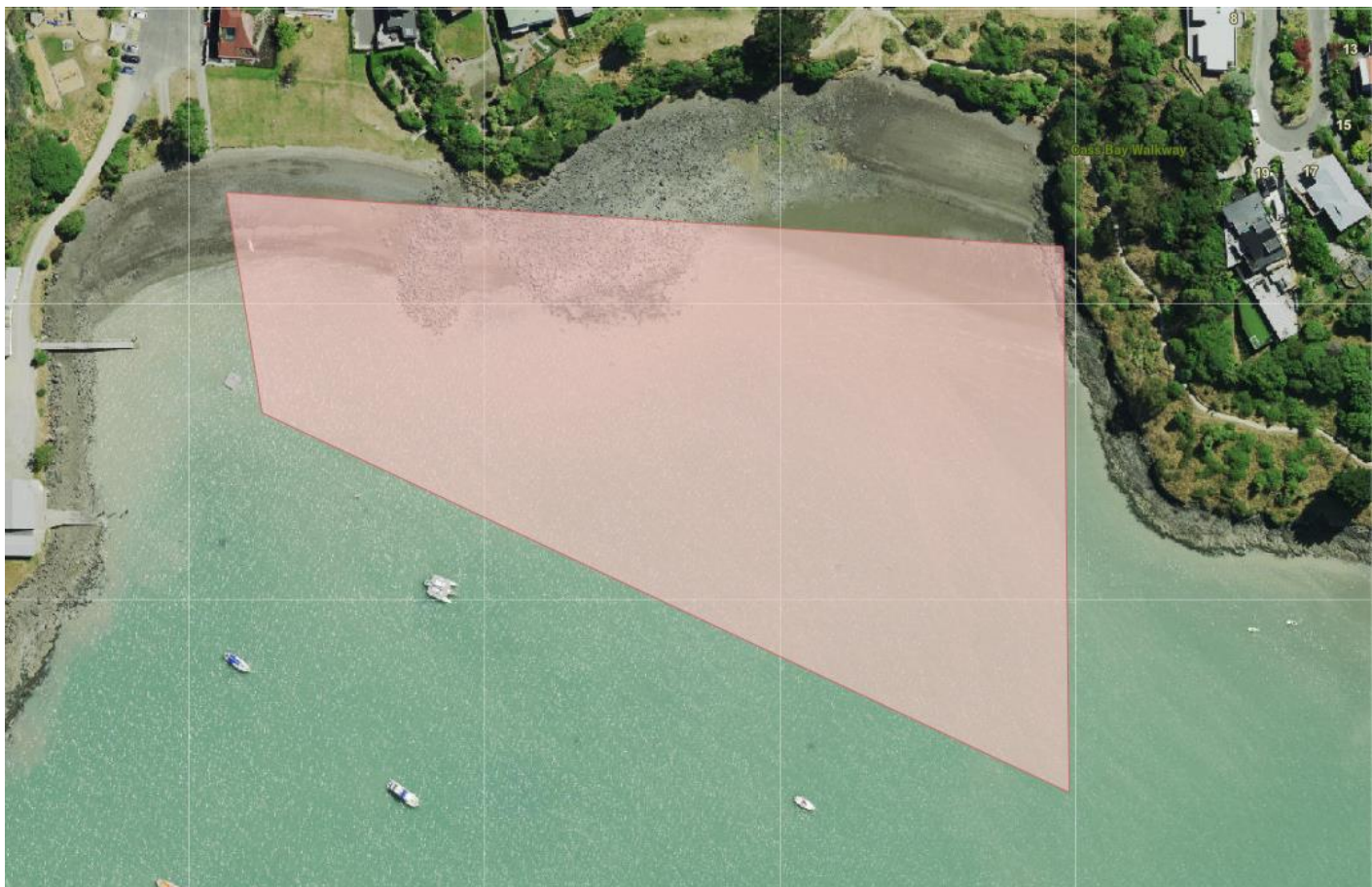


Temporary Reservation Certificate, issued pursuant to:  
Canterbury Regional Council Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016  
Clauses 12 and 32.

Name of holder: <b>Canterbury Triathlon Club, John Newsom</b>
Period: <b>From: 0600 on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2024 until 1000 on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2024; or Until revoked by the Harbourmaster.</b>
Reserved Area: <b>All that area of Cass Bay, inshore of the permanent moorings, see shaded area on attached map.</b>
Map attached: <b>Yes/No</b>
Purpose: <b>For the safety of swimmers participating in a Triathlon event.</b>
Reservation: <b>No vessel shall navigate within the Reserved Area as listed above except with the express permission of, and in a manner explicitly approved by, the certificate holder or his delegate.</b>
Conditions: Publication of notice of Reservation: <b>Notification to known affected groups; notifications on appropriate websites and social media; notices at known boat ramps and key access points.</b>
Notice of Reservation to be: Displayed at: <b>As above.</b> Displayed by: <b>John Newsom (or delegate).</b> Removed by: <b>John Newsom (or delegate); or the Harbourmaster</b>
A copy of the Temporary Reservation Certificate to be carried by: <b>The safety patrol vessels and event director.</b>
Safety conditions: <b>All persons on support vessels to wear correctly fitted PFD's at all times. 5 knot speed restriction to be adhered to, with the exception of responding to an emergency. A copy of this exemption must be carried on all support vessels and by the event organiser.</b>
Temporary Reservation shall not take effect if: <b>Conditions above are not met.</b>
