Safety conditions: As per submitted safety plan, including, but not limited to: Multiple (clearly marked) safety patrol vessels that are in direct contact with the Water Safety Coordinator, to ensure the area is clear of all unauthorised vessels within the reserved area, the broken red line and fixed red line indicated on the attached chartlet are in order to indicate the Reserved Area to vessels. All vessels are to adhere to Navigation Safety Bylaw 2016, including speed close to shore (except in emergency) and wearing of lifejackets. All patrol vessel skippers are to be sufficiently skilled in operating vessel. All on water staff to be thoroughly briefed on the Aquatic Management Plan
